

The principal of the applicant is involved in a case that they filed as Plaintiff, that has no relation to this application: Murchison v. Sherborn Board of Appeals, 485 Mass. 209 (2020).

The Murchison v. Sherborn Board of Appeals case does not involve the locus, but a different property on a different street in Sherborn. Second, that SJC case dismissed Robert Murchison's personal lawsuit against the Town over two years ago, after overturning a decision of the Appeals Court finding that Mr. Murchison had standing to appeal the underlying decision of the Board of Appeals. No remand of that aspect of that decision is pending, therefore the substantive litigation involved in that matter has been completed. The only pending matter as it relates to that litigation is a frivolous claim about fees asserted by the former owners of the unrelated Sherborn parcel. The claim for fees was rejected by the Land Court and by a Single Justice of the Appeals Court. While we don't consider this pending litigation since the underlying substantive litigation was resolved, we provide for informational purposes.
