Any exemption granted will be valid for the current license year only and must be reviewed annually.

for an exemption, please take into consideration the Board of Health meeting schedule and the information or statements about antibody titers or levels are irrelevant. When submitting a request to the Board of Health prior to their next regularly scheduled meeting. Please note that any specific disease, condition, or therapy that makes rabies inoculation unavoidable must be submitted exempt from the annual rabies inoculation requirement. A letter from your veterinarian stating the in accordance with MGL 140 section 137, the local Board of Health is authorized to declare a dog
