Good evening, Rick--

Tetra Tech addressed and/or amended its responses to the issues I flagged in my January 3 email to you (forwarded below), except one. I didn't have a chance to raise this at the last meeting before we moved on to other issues and plan to raise it tonight unless you prefer I not and can ask TT directly to address it. The issue arises in connection with TT's Comment 9, as my 1/3 email noted:

Comment 9. Although TT apparently found sufficient VAI's assertion that "[t]he number of school age children residing in [four residential projects totaling more than 200 additional residential units . . . north and west of the site that] is relatively small and a subset of this small number will consist of middle school and high school age children," there is no apparent foundation for that assertion and accordingly no apparent foundation for VAI's additional conclusion that "the [vehicle] trips attributable to school-related traffic from these projects would be reflected in the general background traffic growth rate." **Note, this statement about the small number of school-aged children residing in 200 residential units presumably was the one which ZBA member Todd Labbe also questioned at the December 14 hearing.**
