Per Board of Health Regulations §305—2.1(C): Permit Application, a completed application shall include (a.) a plan drawn to scale, indicating the boundary lines of the applicant's property, the location and number of wells, and the location of all existing and proposed structures and sewage disposal systems within 200 feet of each existing or proposed well on the applicants property and the location of any existing or proposed driveway, right-of-way, or traveled way (b.) the location of areas subject to the jurisdiction of the Conservation Commission for the proposed well location; (c.) written approval from the Conservation Commission in the form of an Administrative Approval, Negative Determination of Applicability, or Order of Conditions from the Conservation Commission for the proposed well location; and (d.) if a new or replacement sewage disposal system is required, a complete disposal works construction permit application is required.
