

ARTICLE V
Water Testing Requirements for Food Establishment Permits

§ 305-5.1. Testing required.

No food establishment permit will be granted without prior submission to the Board of Health of the results of the analysis of the well water supply. The well water shall be tested for chemical, physical, and bacteriological characteristics that are required by the Board of Health.

§ 305-5.2. Testing procedure.

Test samples shall be taken within the sixty-day period preceding the issuance off the permit that is issued on January 1 for the calendar year. Testing shall be by a Massachusetts certified laboratory. The quality of the water shall comply with the requirements of the Board of Health.
